Literacy

This term we are beginning by learning about pronouns and how they are used in writing. Later on we will learn the importance of using commas correctly.

Texts we will be studying this term include Voices in the Park, Beowulf, Where my wellies take me and Lost Words.

Numeracy

This term we will be securing our understanding of written methods of calculation. We also will learn how to divide and multiply by 10 and 100. We will also be learning how to tell the time accurately.

We will begin to memorise our timestables in preparation for the new national testing of timestable knowledge in the Summer Term.

Science

We will be learning about the different states of matter and how we can change materials.

We will continue to develop our enquiry skills through these topics.

We will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons for history.

Later in the term we will be developing our mapping skills through walks around our local area. This links with our reading of *Where My Wellies Take me*. We are also studying landscapes in art.
