Expectations for pupils at home

Remote learning expectations

For pupils not in school.

Parents should also read the rules and ensure their children follow them. Parents should contact the Headteacher if they think their child might not be able to comply with some or all of the rules, so we can consider alternative arrangements with them and support them with their learning.

- All pupils should log in to their classroom each day.
- Pupils should seek help if they need it, from teachers or other staff members.
- Pupils alert teachers if they're not able to complete work
- Pupils must use proper online conduct, such as using appropriate language in messages
- Please can we ask that parents keep an eye on emails/ 'phones so that you do not miss communications from school.

During live lessons, pupils are expected to behave appropriately by:

- Being on time
- Having books and stationary ready before class begins
- Muting their microphone when asked
- Turning on their camera when asked
- Maintaining eye contact when asked
- Raising their hand to ask questions, or using the relevant online class participation feature
- Not disrupting the lesson for others by messaging about something other than school work

Dealing with problems

If there are any problems with pupils adhering to rules around remote learning, including if they don't engage with the remote learning set for them, we will:
