



Other work
 In **geography** we are looking at maps of our local area, carrying out fieldwork and producing our own route maps. We will also be looking at features of the Yorkshire coast.
 Our **RE** unit this term is based on religious festivals and why they are important to different people. We will be discussing what we enjoy celebrating and why this is important to us.
 In **computing** we are learning to program using logo and scratch.
 In **art** we will be designing and making our own prints followed by developing our painting techniques.
 Our **music** unit is duration and silence. We will be listening and composing music using different note lengths and rests.
 In **DT** we will be evaluating, designing and baking biscuits for the Jubilee celebration.

Spring Term
 Mrs Leppington teaches Mondays and Tuesdays. Mrs Pool teaches Thursdays and Fridays. We are both in school on Wednesdays.
Literacy
 This term with Mrs Leppington we are looking at the features of an autobiography and writing our own. We will also be studying seaside poetry.
 With Mrs Pool we will be studying 'The Tin-Forest' by Helen Ward and Wayne Anderson. In the second half term, we will be reading 'Tuesday' by David Weisner which will lead to us writing and performing a news report.
Numeracy
 This term with Mrs Leppington we will be learning about fractions and decimals as well as using the four operations.
 With Mrs Pool we will be learning about length, perimeter and area. We will also be practicing measures, including mass and capacity.
Science
 This term we will be learning about plants. This will include identifying different types of plants and what they need to grow healthily. We will be using our local area for investigations during this topic.

Other information

Our PE days are Tuesdays and Wednesdays. However, we may do PE sessions on other days so kits do need to be kept in school during the week. Please make sure any jewellery worn can be removed independently. Wellies also need to be in school as we hope to make use of the outdoor space and woodland whenever possible.

Homework

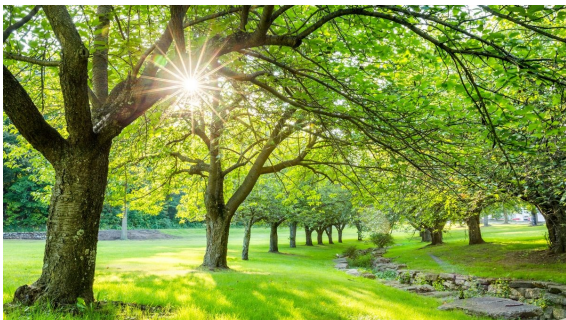
