

Welcome to the Spring Term in Oak Class.

In literacy we are going to be writing superhero stories after reading Traction Man. Later in the term we will be finding out about Edward Lear's poetry and writing non-fiction recounts. Phonics and/or guided reading continues to take place every day in school for Reception and Y1. Year 2s are continuing learning spelling patterns.

In maths we are looking at counting patterns of 2, 5 and 10 leading into multiplication and division. Later we will be adding and subtracting more complex calculations. Mrs Thomson will be teaching time and weight.

In science we are learning about humans. We will find out about growing, our senses and how to keep healthy. We will be referring to the NSPCC Pantosaurus website in relation to personal privacy.

In geography we are learning about the 4 countries of the UK, their capital cities and traditions. Later in the term we are looking at the history of transport. We will make wheeled vehicles in DT using junk modelling.

In music we are thinking about tempo and will be composing short rhythmic phrases. In RE we are learning about sacred places.

We will be painting in art.
