

Science In Science, we are learning about animals and habits. We will be considering food chains in different habitats and learning about the human skeleton and different muscles in our bodies.

Other work In **History** we are going to be focusing on the King's Coronation. We will be learning about similarities and differences between coronations throughout British history. In **RE** we will be learning about what religious and non-religious groups teach us about deciding what is right and wrong. In **computing** we will be learning how to program to achieve different outcomes and debug in order to solve problems. In **Art**, we will be using water colours to create bird art. We will then create our own sewn bird pictures using our learning of sewing techniques. In **Design Technology** we will be designing, creating and evaluating a purse/wallet that children will be able to use at the Summer Fair. In **PSHE** we are learning about relationships, including how to identify if they are healthy.

Literacy
In literacy with Mrs Leppington, we will be studying Charles Causley poetry before reading some poetry of our own. We will then be reading 'Fox' by Margaret Wild and Ron Brooks and considering the themes explored in the text.
With Mrs Pool in Literacy, we will be reading Paddington stories to develop comprehension and to support writing our own adventure story. In the second half term we will be reading and writing instructions.
Numeracy
In Numeracy with Mrs Leppington, we will be learning about fractions and decimals. We will be revisiting all 4 operations and learning how to answer worded questions.
In Numeracy with Mrs Pool, we will be learning to tell the time, measure length and will practise handling money.
