

Welcome to the Summer Term in Oak Class.

In literacy we are going to be reading a variety of high-quality texts linked to our hygiene nature themes. We will use these texts to improve our own sentence structures and our use of punctuation. We will focus on non-fiction writing and poetry after half-term.

In maths we are solving worded problems and Reception will be learning about numbers beyond 10. We will then spend some time looking at puzzles and reasoning problems. Mrs Thomson will be teaching time, capacity, money and shape.



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In science we are learning about plants. We will plant seeds, observe them over time and find out the best conditions for growing plants. We will explore the plants in our local area and talk about similarities and differences.

In geography we will learn about how climates changes around the globe and learn how different European explorers discovered more about each continent. In ICT we will learn about animation and in music we are thinking about duration and silence. In RE we are learning about religious stories.

We will be making 3-D art and designing our own fruit salad in DT.
