

Our literacy work will focus on nursery rhymes and stories with settings related to our nature curriculum. We will learn some rhymes by heart and have a go at making up our own rhymes.

This year we are following the Little Wandle phonics and reading scheme. This will be similar to before; all Reception and Year 1s will have a daily phonics lesson and regular reading practice in school. Advice on the home reading books will be found inside the cover of your child's reading record book. Year 2s will also have regular reading sessions in school and is essential that they read frequently at home too.

Welcome to the Autumn Term in Oak Class.

Our themes for the term are nursery rhymes and the weather. We will be asking questions about the weather and observing seasonal changes. In history we will learn how the weather contributed to the Great Fire of London. In art we will be exploring printing with paint and then learning different drawing techniques. We will be learning how to use the tablets to write in computing. We will be learning about dynamics in music and learning Christmas songs later in the term. This ties in with our RE work on religious celebrations.

In maths we will be learning about place value and patterns in number. We will move onto addition and subtraction later in the term.

Please ensure that your child has their PE kits, wellies and coat in school every day as we often go for walks, play and learn outdoors in all weathers. Please can you double check that all kit, wellies and uniform are NAMED clearly, especially if you have previously used a biro to name items as this can fade over time.
