

In science we are learning about materials. We will find out about their properties and where they come from. We will learn why recycling is important.

In history we will be learning about changes that have occurred in living memory with a focus on toys and household objects. Look out for another letter asking for help with this. In geography we will be comparing Welburn and Malton.

We will be painting in art and designing our own sandwich in DT. We will be learning about instruments of the orchestra in music. In RE we will explore what it means to belong to a faith community.

In literacy we are going to read some traditional tales and write our own stories. After half-term we will learn how to write instructions and read some poetry.

In maths Year 2 will be exploring multiplication and division whilst Year 1 will be learning more about teens numbers and how to add and subtract them. Reception will be investigating numbers to 10. Mrs Thomson will continue to teach shape and measure.

Phonics (or spelling) and reading continue to be taught daily. Please listen to your child read at home as often as possible and ask them questions about what they have read. Reading TO your child is also invaluable.
