

In science we are learning about what animals need to live and different ways we can group them. We will be visiting Monks Park Farm.

We will be making animals puppets in DT and in geography we will be learning about Tokyo in Japan.

In music we are learning about rhythms and texture.

We are learning about the artist Matisse and how to collage in art.

In RE we are learning more about the Jewish religion.

We will also learn about the Olympic Games.

This term our topic is animals.

In literacy we are going to read stories and poems about animals and write our own versions. We will also be reading and writing non-fiction information. Phonics continues to take place every day in school, complemented by regular reading sessions. Please continue to listen to your child read at home as frequently as possible as well as enjoying reading to your children.

In maths we will consolidate our learning on adding and subtracting, investigate patterns and learn more about shape, mass and capacity. Reception will be learning about bonds of numbers to 10.

In PSHE we will be thinking about moving on within school as we grow older. We will learn to reflect on what we have achieved this year and think about our aims for the future.

PE continues to be on a Wednesday (or sometimes a Thursday). Please ensure your child has a named PE kit in school at all times.

Please also ensure any sunhats, sun-cream and jumpers are clearly named as these items can easily get misplaced when the weather warms up.
